OFFICIAL RULES

- Poster topic must represent dentalhealth or dental-hygiene issues.
- Paper must be no larger than 8.5 inches by 11 inches.
- No computer-generated art will be accepted.
- Only third-grade students are eligible to enter. One entry per student is allowed. (Special education students up to age 12 may enter the contest.)
- PDA must receive entries no later than the specified deadline.
- All posters become the property of PDA once they have been submitted.
- PDA employees' and members' immediate families are not eligible.
- Teachers should clearly print the student's name, age and home address, their own name, the school's name address, county and phone number on the back of the classroomwinner's poster.

Posters will be judged on dental health or hygiene theme, creativity and neatness.
